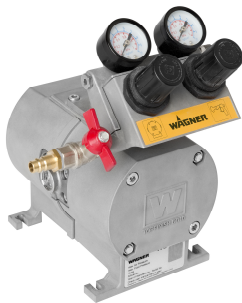

### **New from WAGNER: Double diaphragm pump TOPFINISH DD10** **Best finishing results with a clear cost saving**

With the WAGNER TOPFINISH DD10, a new pneumatically-operated double diaphragm pump for supplying manual and automatic Airspray guns is being launched on the market. It can be used when staining wooden furniture, coating metal parts, and applying chrome paint to plastic parts, for example.

The decisive advantage of WAGNER TOPFINISH DD10 is its pulsation-free material flow without the use of a material pressure regulator as is the case in conventional pumps, which aside from high procurement costs, would only cause additional waste, flush volumes, and maintenance costs. As a result, the user benefits from a uniform spray pattern and optimum coating quality.



The pump is equipped with two precision adjustable regulators for pump pressure and atomized air, as well as two pressure gauges, enabling the pump to be used extremely easily and quickly. For optimum handling, the operating unit can be fitted both lengthwise and crosswise to the pump. This enables the WAGNER TOPFINISH DD10 to be integrated into the widest variety of installations without any problems.

The parts that come into contact with the material are made exclusively of stainless steel. Thus, with a single version of the pump, all applications can be carried out and materials processed. There will therefore be no additional retooling costs, even in the event of a subsequent material change. The low pump volume results in a reduction of waste by up to 70% in contrast to comparable pumps, as less material has to be flushed out prior to a color change. A significant amount of solvents is also saved in the process. Due to the optimized flushing capabilities, even epoxy and PU-based materials can be processed with ease. In addition, time and money is also saved as a result of the extremely straightforward maintenance – to disassemble and assemble the pump, the user requires just four standard tools, and a diaphragm change takes less than 10 minutes.
